21-year-old JUNO Award-nominated R&B artist Dylan Sinclair has cemented himself as one of the genre's most promising up-and-coming stars with new EP *No Longer in the Suburbs*.

Recently named one of **Apple Music's *R&B Artists to Watch for in 2022***, 21-year-old Toronto native Dylan Sinclair is fresh off the release of his critically acclaimed EP, *No Longer in the Suburbs*, out now independently via **Five Stone Records/The Orchard**. The coming-of-age record includes standout singles "Lifetime" and "Suppress" featured on flagship playlist covers across **Spotify, Apple, Amazon, YouTube, and TIDAL** gaining Dylan over **600K monthly listeners** on Spotify alone and over **3 million worldwide streams** across the EP to date.

*No Longer in the Suburbs* finds the **Filipino-Guyanese** musician stepping into himself as he transitions from teenager to young adult – all while remaining grounded, authentic, and aware that this is only the beginning. In support of the EP, Dylan performed at the **2022 JUNO Fest**, made his debut at the **world's largest Jazz festival in Montréal**, and is gearing up for his appearance at **Manifesto Festival in Toronto** performing alongside fellow major R&B acts like **Jazmine Sullivan** and **Tems**.

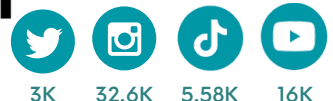
Dubbed an "**R&B king in the making**" (**Complex**), *No Longer in the Suburbs* has garnered praise in **The Toronto Star**, **Billboard**, **BET**, **Complex**, **Vibe**, **UPROXX**, **Teen VOGUE**, and **ESSENCE** who have all been invigorated by Sinclair's fresh take on R&B. Sinclair has collaborated with fellow R&B artists like **Joyce Wrice**, **Savannah Ré**, and **Emanuel** as well as a variety of respected producers including **Boi-1da** (**Drake**, **Rihanna**, **Eminem**, **Cardi B**), **Jordon Manswell** (**Daniel Caesar**, **Mariah Carey**, **Chris Brown**), and **Marcus Semaj** (**Giveon**, **Snoh Aalegra**, **dvsn**).

Sinclair began writing and recording at age 15 and in 2018 issued his debut EP, *Red Like Crimson*, which caught the attention of GRAMMY and JUNO Award-nominated Toronto producer **Jordon Manswell** (**Daniel Caesar**, **Mariah Carey**, **Chris Brown**). In 2020, they collaborated on their first effort, *Proverb*, which garnered the duo a highly coveted nomination for **Traditional R&B/Soul Recording of The Year** at the **2021 JUNO Awards** and has surpassed **25 million streams** to date.

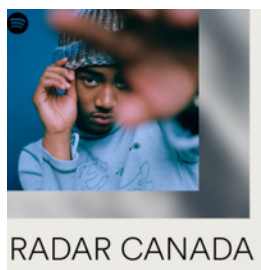

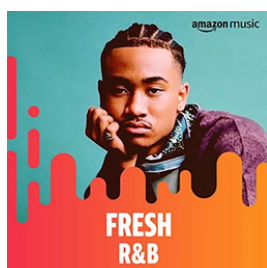
